CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

The Department of Public and Community Health, School of Public Health, University of West Attica, organizes and operates from the academic year 2023-2024 a Postgraduate Studies Program (MSc) entitled:

«Environmental health and communication in general and special education and training»

Establishment of the MSc (Government Gazette 2495/20-5-2022), Studies Regulation (Government Gazette 3158/22-6-2022) in accordance with the provisions of Law 4485/2017 and Law 4957/2022, as in force.

General Information

The Postgraduate Studies Programme (MSc) entitled "Environmental health and communication in general and special education and training" of the Department of Public and Community Health of the School of Public Health of the University of West Attica aims to further promote scientific knowledge, to develop research and to provide graduates with high level expertise in theoretical and applied areas on issues related to the promotion of responsible environmental health and communication in general and special education and training. In particular, it aims to equip postgraduate students with critical evaluation skills in relation to issues of environmental texture and special education and training. These skills must be integrated and disseminated in order to promote the educational process in the school environment, both in general and special education, and in the community in general. These skills will enable those concerned to participate and lead the processes of implementation of corresponding educational - and not only - programs for both the general population and people with special needs, thus determining the quality of health and the environment in the coming decades.

The courses are taught by distance learning and, where appropriate, face-to-face. The duration of the studies leading to the award of the Postgraduate Diploma (M.Sc.) of the Program is set at three (3) academic semesters and is structured in two (2) academic semesters of teaching, each semester corresponding to 30 credit hours (ECTS), as well as one semester for the writing of a postgraduate thesis (30 ECTS). A total of ninety (90) credit hours are required for the award of the M.Sc. degree.

The allowed duration of the completion of the requirements for the Master's degree cannot be less than three (3) academic semesters. Courses may be held on all days of the week to accommodate graduate students/three who have concurrent professional employment. Holders of a university or technological degree from higher educational institutions in the domestic territory, as well as holders of corresponding foreign degrees recognised by the IOATAP, are admitted to the MSc. For all candidates, a prerequisite is the knowledge of English language at least B2 level (good knowledge) certified by the submission of relevant qualifications according to the Special Annex (A2) of the Language Proof of the A.S.E.P. of 14/1/2022.

Application Procedure & Timetable

Required Documents Interested candidates may submit their application online, accompanied by the required documents, until Friday 30 June 2023 at 23:59. In particular, the following documents must be submitted:

1. Application form for the MSc (available via the website of the MSc "Environmental health and communication in general and special education and training" <https://pchenvihealth.uniwa.gr/>)
2. Copy(s) of diploma(s). Qualifications obtained abroad must be accompanied by a recognition of equivalence/correspondence by the D.O.A.T.A.P.
3. Certificate of studies with detailed grades of all courses or obligations of the degree, including the final grade of the degree, numerically and accurately.
4. A full curriculum vitae, detailing qualifications and any research or professional activities, including at the end the full names, titles and e-mail contact details of the two persons who will be asked for letters of recommendation.
5. Copies of English language qualifications mandatory and any other certificates relating to other foreign languages.
6. A declaration that they have read and understood the Regulations of the MSc "Environmental Health and Communication in General and Special Education and Education".

Final year students may also submit supporting documents provided that they have submitted a graduation certificate or a copy of their diploma at the beginning of the first semester of the course.

Candidates are required to submit the application to the email of the MSc Secretariat master.envihealth@uniwa.gr accompanied by the required documents. Interviews of the candidates will be held at a time to be communicated through electronic communication with the candidates.
